


### What is Visual Literacy?







The ability to construct meaning from images or other visual forms of information.



Devices used in 2017











### How to search these places?



### Reverse Engineering



#### Metadata

- Title
- Date
- Medium
- Creator
- Anything else that could be in a caption

#### Description

- Technically part of metadata
- A few sentences or a phrase that describes the contents of the image
- Part of accessibility standards

#### Currency

timeliness of the information

**P** elevance

how the information fits your needs

**A** uthority

the source of the information

**A**ccuracy

reliability and correctness of the information

**D** urpose

the reason the information exists

- CREDIBILITY How do you know the information and author are authentic and reliable?
- ACCURACY How do you know the information is up-todate, factual, detailed, and comprehensive?
- REASONABLENESS How do you know the information is fair, objective, moderate, and consistent?
- SUPPORT How reliable, accurate, reasonable and wellsupported are the sources for your resource?






